All contestants will compete in five preliminary events to qualify as one of the five contestants who earn the right to move on to the championship round "The Masters Challenge." The preliminary events include Ascent Event, Belayed Speed Climb, Aerial Rescue, Work Climb and Throw Line. Prizes and Plaques will be awarded to the top finishers in each preliminary event in accordance with the Midwestern Chapter MW-TCC Prize Distribution Policy.

The winner of the Masters Challenge will be awarded a special prize package of state-of-the-art climbing gear as well as the peer recognition which comes with their victory. ISA CEU credits will be available for the climbers and volunteer participants.
